	Reykjavík-	during the summer months drives the mountain tracks that lead	
	Landmannalaugar-	to Landmannalaugar, passing by the Hekla volcano and other	
	Hrafntinnusker	volcanoes in the Dómadalur area. Arriving in Landmannalaugar	
		at noon, we have lunch and time for a quick soak in the hot	
		springs and then head south into the mountains. The trail takes	
		us past small gorges, steaming hot springs and yellow mountain	
		ridges. Arrival at Hrafntinnusker mountain hut, where we will	
		stay the night, in the late afternoon. Distance: 12km (7.5 mi)	
		Walking time: 4-5 hrs.	
		Ascent: 470 m (1540 ')	Overnight Hrafntinnusker hut
Mon Sept 4	Trek Day 2:	From Hrafntinnusker we descend in the gullies of Jökultungur	(B, L, D)
Mon Sept 4	Hrafntinnusker-	with hundreds of steaming hot springs and mud pools. Up there	(B, L, D)
	Álftavatn	we enjoy fascinating views to the south to the Álftavatn area	
		(Swan Lake), and the Mýrdalsjökull and Eyjafjallajökull	
		glaciers. In the afternoon we arrive at Álftavatn hut where we	
		stay the night.	
		Distance: 12km (7.5 mi)	
		Walking time: 4-5 hrs.	,
		Descent: 490 m (1610 ')	Overnight Álftavatn hut
Tues Sept 5	Trek Day 3	We pass at the foot of the green conic volcano of Stórasúla	(B, L, D)
	Álftavatn-Emstrur	before entering the black deserts of Mælifellssandur. Heading	
		towards another ancient and verdurous volcano, the Hattfell, we	
		enter the Emstrur region where farmers used to graze their sheep in summer. Before arriving at the Botnar hut where we	
		stay the night, we visit the magnificent Markarfljót canyon cut	
		almost 200 m down into the rocks south of Hattfell.	
		Distance: 16km (10 mi)	
		Walking time: 6-7 hrs.	
		Descent: 40 m (130 ')	Overnight Botnar hut
Wed Sept 6	Trek Day 4	We continue up and down through the small valleys and gullies	(B, L, D)
	Emstrur-Þórsmörk	of Emstrur, where the great Mýrdalsjökull glacier rises only a	
		couple of kilometers away. At the end of the day the vegetation	
		starts to grow thicker and higher as we descend in to Þórsmörk's	
		(the woods of Thor) green valleys filled with arctic birch forests	
		and colorful flowers. Night in one of the huts in Þórsmörk.	
		Distance: 17km (10.5 mi)	
		Walking time: 6-7 hrs. Descent: 300 m (985 ')	Overnight hut in Þórsmörk
Thurs Sept 7	Trek Day 5	We spend the morning in Þórsmörk where we walk along one of	(B)
	Tick Buy 5	numerous paths. For example, we can visit the Sönghellir cave	(B)
		(Song cave), climb up the small mountain of Valahnúkur from	
		where magnificent views can be enjoyed, before taking the	
		afternoon bus to Reykjavík. Arrival at Reykjavík BSI bus	
		terminal where the trip ends at 19:30. Transfer to hotel on own.	
		Or continue on to the South Coast add on.	Overnight Reykjavik

		where we will explore the beauty of the canyon and	
		enjoy the stunning views of the surrounding
