The two and a half hour boat trip takes us along the glassy river surrounded by majestic limestone cliffs and mysterious caves, as well as past rural scenes of rice paddies and deserted green fields. We will then continue exploring the area by bicycle on a 45-minute tour around the village to discover the life of the local people.
